Introduction

This document explains how to setup TAserver as a service on your network.

- A. Installing third party vendor software “Application as Service” from Eltima Software
- B. Setting up TA-Server as a service
- C. Turning TA-Server as a service OFF for performing TA Administration functions
- D. Turning TA-Server as a service back ON

A) Installing third party vendor software “Application as Service”

- Download the latest version of Application as Service at:
http://www.eltima.com/download/application_service.exe
- Double click it using any file manager or Windows Explorer in order to start installation process



- Follow the prompts given, study the License Agreement carefully, select the destination path and choose shortcuts you wish to be created.
- Finish installation.

- Finally you will need to navigate either to the Start Menu and locate the launcher in Programs submenu or double-click the shortcut created on the desktop, if you chose this option, or simply launch Application as Service directly from the installer.




B) Setting up TA-Server as a service

1. Start up “TA-Server”.



- a. Double-click the icon on your desktop or open it from “ProgramFiles\TeamAgendaServer\TeamAgendasServer.exe”
- b. Make sure that the correct *.tdb is selected; “Configuration\TeamName...”
- c. Make sure that all your licenses are entered; “Configuration\License”
- d. Make sure that you have the correct port number: “Configuration\Network Protocols...”
- e. Quit TA-Server

2. Start up “Application as a Service”



Double-click the icon on your desktop or open it from “ProgramFiles\Eltima Software\Application Service\Launch Application as Service 3.0.exe”


3. Setup “TA-Server” as a service.

- a. From the “Main window” tool bar,




Click on the button to launch the “create service” dialog box.

- b. From the “Create service” dialog box click on the browser icon to locate the TA-Server application. The default is “ProgramFiles\Teamsoft\TeamAgendaServer\TServer.exe”.






c. Using the “Open” dialog box:




Select the “TA-Server” program.

Click the “Open” button to open the “TA-Server” program.

d. To create “TA-Server” as a service:




Click on the  button



- e. If you see ‘TA-Server’ in the “Services list” panel below, you have successfully created “TA-Server” as a service.

You need to configure ‘TA-Server’ to start automatically:


From the “Main Menu”, double click to select “TA-Server” from the “Service List” screen below to edit the options for “TA-Service”.



Click on the  tab on the left hand side.

In the “Control options” section, select “Automatic” from the list window of the “Startup type”.


Click on the  button to save the update.





C) Turning TA-Server as a service OFF for performing TA Administration functions


1. Start up “Application as a Service”



Double-click the icon on the desktop or open it from “ProgramFiles\Eltima Software\Application Service\Launch Application as Service 3.0.exe”

2. Stop “TA-Server” as a service.

Click to select “TA-Server” from the “Service List” screen below.



Click the  button to STOP “TA-Server” as a service.

4. Start up “TA-Server”.




Double-click the icon on desktop or open it from “ProgramFiles\TeamAgendaServer\TeamAgendasServer.exe”.

Now you are able to perform your administration functions.



D) Turning TA-Server as a service back ON


1. Start up “Application as a Service”



Double-click the icon on desktop or open it from “ProgramFiles\Eltima Software\Application Service\Launch Application as Service 3.0.exe”

2. Start “TA-Server” as a service.

Click to select “TA-Server” from the “Service List” screen below.



Click the  button to START “TA-Server” as a service.
